Skit #1: Love and Belonging

Why: This skit shows a new student (Mia) feeling nervous and alone, but then being invited to join a group by Zoe. It highlights the importance of friendship, feeling accepted, and being part of a group.

Title: You can sit with us

Characters: 😊 *Mia (new student) *Zoe(friendly classmate) *Teacher Lee	Setting: *School cafeteria during lunchtime
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(Scene opens with Mia standing alone, holding a lunch tray, looking around nervously.)

Character	Dialogue
Mia	This is my first day... I don't know where to sit.
Zoe	I see someone new. Maybe she needs a friend!
Teacher Lee	Let's all remember to include others during lunchtime.
Mia	Everyone already has a group... Maybe I'll just eat alone.
Zoe	Hey! You can sit with me if you want!
Teacher Lee	Zoe, that's a great way to make someone feel welcome.
Mia	Thanks! I was feeling really nervous.
Zoe	No problem! Want to play with us after lunch too?
Teacher Lee	Now <i>that</i> is how we build a kind classroom.

Skit #2: Safety Needs

Why: This skit focuses on helping children feel safe during a fire drill. Mr. James reassures the students and guides them calmly, showing how physical and emotional safety are important for children to feel secure.

Title: The Fire Drill

Characters: 😊 Mr. James (Teacher) Ella (Student) Students (as a group)	Setting: Preschool classroom
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Beginning (Introduction):

(Scene opens in a preschool room. Children are playing when the fire alarm suddenly rings.)

Mr.James	Alright class, remember what we practiced!
Ella	That sound is so loud... what's happening?
Students	Is it a real fire?
Mr.James	It's just a drill, but we must take it seriously.
Ella	I'm scared, what if something goes wrong?
Students	Let's hold hands and stay close.
Mr.James	You all did amazing. This is how we stay safe.
Ella	I feel better now that I know what to do.
Students	We're like a team—go to class!
